Subject: Displaying information in respect of final Bills and status of applications for registration of contractors on CPWD Website.

Reference is invited to OM Nos. 2/2/2007-S&D/369 dated 20.3.07 and No. 387 dated 28.3.07 on the issue of displaying certain information the web for improving vigilance administration by leveraging technology. Copies of these circulars are again endorsed herewith for ready reference.


In this regard it is mentioned that information has been received only from few Zones and there also the latest information has not been furnished again. Information furnished has been uploaded on the website of CPWD which may be seen by the units which had forwarded the details. Discrepancy, if any, may be brought to the notice of the S&D Unit.

The JS & CVO, CPWD, has mentioned that the CVC has taken strong exception to proper steps not being taken to introduce transparency in working which can result in reduction in corruption etc.

All concerned are requested to take note of the instructions issued the OMs referred above and arrange to furnish the desired information on a regular monthly basis till arrangements are made for updating of the details by the field units directly.

**Subject: Information in respect of Final Bills pending for more than six months.**

The CVC has issued instructions for improving vigilance administration by leveraging technology vide its circular No. 40/11/06 dated 22.11.06. This issue was reviewed by Secretary (UD) in a meeting convened in the Ministry on 19.3.06. As a step towards improving vigilance administration by introducing greater transparency in the working of the department it has been decided that details of final bills of all works pending for more than six months, from the date of completion of the work, will be displayed on the website by each field unit.

Initially the information will have to be furnished by the zones after collecting the information from the field divisions and submitted to the S&D Unit for publishing on the CPWD Website. Shortly, a form will be developed and displayed on the web which will enable all the divisions to upload this information directly from their own end.

In view of the sensitivity of the issue it is requested that the matter may be given wide publicity and all the Zones may arrange furnish to supply the information, on a monthly basis, to the S&D Unit regularly. The initial information will be in respect of the bills pending up to 31.3.07 and, then, it will be required to be up dated monthly. The details to be furnished to include the complete name of work, the name of agency, date of completion as recorded, agreement number and brief reasons for not finalizing the bill within six months from the date of completion.

**Subject:** Displaying information in respect of status of applications received in CPWD for registration of Class I/Class II only CPWD Website.

The CVC has issued instructions for improving vigilance administration by leveraging technology vide its circular No. 40/11/2006 dated 22<sup>nd</sup> November 2006 (copy enclosed for ready reference). This circular requires that the status of the applications for registration of contractors/suppliers/consultants/vendors etc. must be displayed on the website of each department. It also requires that the rules for registration of vendors should be displayed on the website. While the rules for registration of contractors/vendors in CPWD are displayed on the CPWD Website, the status of the application of various agencies who are desirous of being registered with CPWD is presently not displayed. This issue has been reviewed by Secretary (UD) in a meeting convened in the Ministry on 19.3.07 and it has been desired that the status of the applications should be displayed on the website and this information should be up dated regularly.

Accordingly it has been decided that, initially, status of applications for registration of contractors in the class I & class II categories, in different disciplines i.e. Civil/Electrical/Horticulture/Furniture etc., shall be displayed on the website. Initially all the registering authorities for Class I and II categories should furnish a monthly information to the S&D Unit for being up loaded on the web. In due course a form will be developed and put up on the CPWD website which can be accessed by the different registering authorities and information up dated regularly from their end.

All concerned are requested to note the above instructions and furnish to the S&D unit the status of the applications under their consideration so that this information can be put up on the website by 31.3.07 and, then, it can up dated regularly.

Attention of all concerned is also invited to para 2 (v) of the circular of CVC wherein the CVC has reiterated that repeated queries in a piecemeal manner should be avoided and this will be construed as a misconduct having vigilance angle. All concerned may note the directions of the CVC.

All concerned are requested to furnish the application accordingly.

A performa on which information is to be furnished is enclosed herewith which may be used to supply the information to the S&D Unit.
