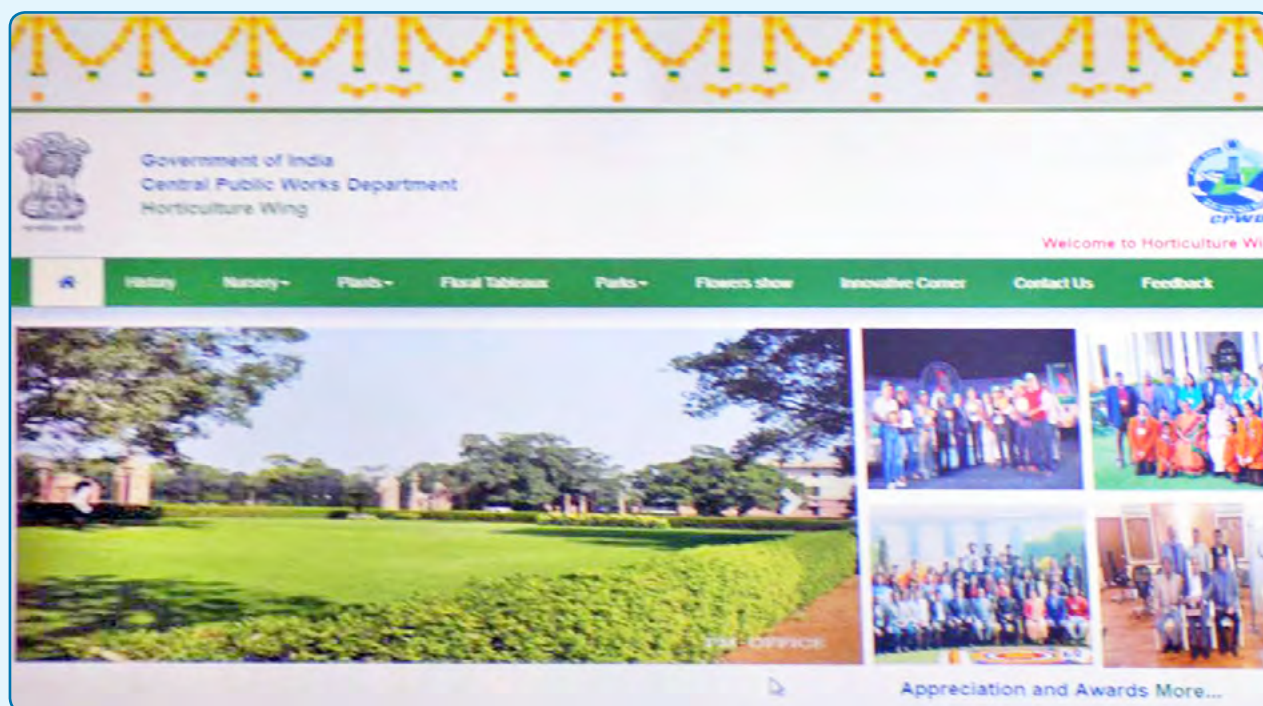

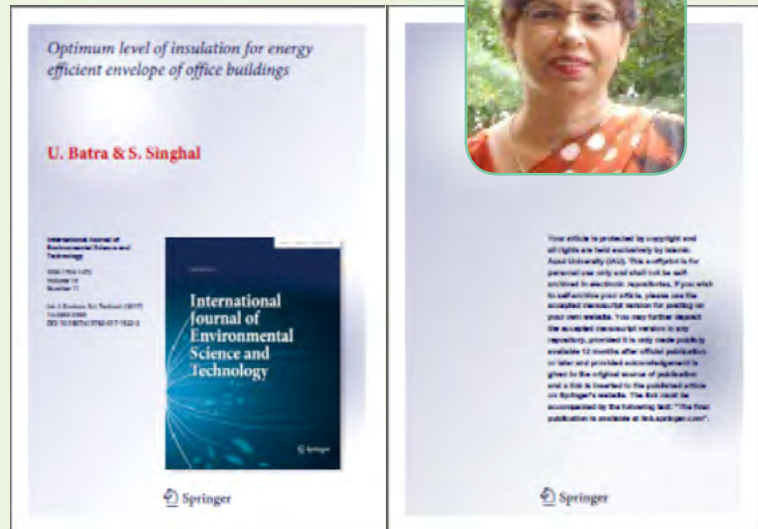
Shri Prabhakar Singh, Director General, CPWD chaired a meeting of Senior Officers on August 9, 2018 in connection with Maintenance Drive.
