FINANCIAL LIMITS FOR ISSUE OF COMPLETION CERTIFICATE

In partial modification of para 30.4 of CPWD Manual vol.II, 1988, before work is declared complete in all respects and final payment is released the Superintending Engineer/Director of Horticulture shall now be required to inspect the following works and record completion certificate:

(i) Building works

(ii) Electrical and Sanitary works

(iii) Road /Runway works

(i Horticulture works

Rs.30 Lakhs and above

Rs. 10 Lakhs and above

Rs. 10 Lakhs and above

Rs.2 Lakhs and above.

For works whose contract value is less than the above, Executive Engineer' Deputy Director of Horticulture shall have to record the completion certificate.

It has also been decided, in partial modification of para 30.7 of the Manual, that the Completion Certificate by Senior Architect/Chief Architect shall be necessary in case of works of value more than Rs.50 Lakhs.
